



Bin Evaluation Program Outline

Your selected group is trained by an experienced industry veteran using the visual tools in the inspection program. They will learn how to identify the various topics related to a Grain Bin and what and where to look for problems. Training also comes with a training workbook & a supply of report forms in a portfolio.

Bin Inspection Training

Using the Serialized Report Forms provided the Inspector documents their findings at the customer's site. Report Forms are designed in levels so that with each concern found, they can provide a closer examination of the concern or problem.

Bin Inspection

Field notes are electronically prepared in a format that can be easily distributed.

Provides the channel to distribute information to relative locations for further review and storage.

Clear Creek Data Base

Clear Creek maintains a confidential database of information reported. This information is later used for providing summaries and reports of your activity.

Quarterly Reports

CCA will provide quarterly reports which provides a summary of all activity submitted by your trained field personnel. It provides an outline of all issues in those reports and permits you to understand and evaluate key issues you may have with Grain Bin Insurability and track field activity.

Clear Creek

Clear Creek Supports all activities with the program and will provide assistance with reporting to the Insurance Company on various issues.

Summary Reports

CCA will prepare a summary report from your field notes, this is intended to provide you with the opportunity to have an outside report evaluation completed on any given situation.

Detailed Report

CCA will provide an in depth report detailing issues found in field notes and offering explanations, possible causes and potential corrective actions.

Insurance Company

All report information comes back into the Insurance Company for their records and review.

No Insurance Offered

Upon review of notes and reports a determination to not offer insurance is made.

Report

A report is issued to the applicant using the findings in the report also copied to the office involved.

Insurance Offered

Applicant receives coverage

Site Improvements Required

Based on the findings of the Bin inspection, Insurance is offered under the condition that specified improvements or repairs be made to the Grain Bin

Insurance Offered

Upon completion of improvements or repairs to the Grain Bin, Insurance is approved.

Site Visit By Engineer

If inadequate information to decide or if significant structural question exists a Professional Engineer with specific experience can complete an Evaluation of the structure to assess its integrity. The information flow repeats.
